Keenaghan Cottage is 5-star thatched cottage by Keenaghan Lough in Co Fermanagh. It was built in the 1800s and has been made very nice. This guide will help you get ready for your stay.

If you have questions about staying at the cottage, you can talk to the host, Lisa. She is friendly and will help you decide if it is right for you.



To get to the cottage, you need a car. It is near Belleek village, not far from Enniskillen Town and Co Donegal. There is free parking at the cottage.



The cottage has two bedrooms and two bathrooms. It can sleep four people. It is in a quiet place with lovely views of the lake. You can stay here, hire it for events, or visit for the day.



The cottage is not good for people who use wheelchairs. There are steps, narrow doors, and uneven floors. The outside has grass and gravel, which can be hard to walk on for those with mobility aids.



Pets can come but must stay off the furniture and out of bedrooms. There is a lake and old stone walls. We recommend that you supervise young children at all times on the property.



Inside there is a warm fire and nice smells from the wood. The cottage does not allow smoking or vaping.



Sensory Tools in Nature



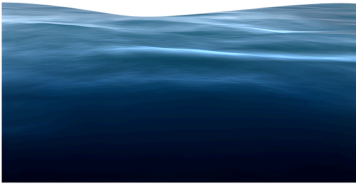
Keenaghan Cottage is surrounded by nature in a quiet countryside, with no traffic or light pollution. The perfect place to relax or explore.



Stop and listen to the sounds around you. Hear the birds singing, and the wind moving through the trees.



Red deer, badgers, foxes, owls and buzzards are all regular visitors to the grounds so keep a look out.



Listen to the lapping of the lough. This can help you relax.



Look at the clouds in the sky. Can you spot shapes? It is calming to notice what's around you.



Put your feet in the grass. Feel the leaves. You can use these textures to stim or feel calm.



Watch how the plants and trees move in the wind. Sway like the trees. Moving your body can feel fun and help you feel good.

Castle Caldwell Forest - Castle Caldwell Forest - An ancient woodland forest with 3 scenic walking trails on the shores of Lower Lough Erne.



Magho Cliffs - A hiking trail up to Lough Navar Forest, offering stunning views over Lower Lough Erne.



Castle Archdale Forest - A forest with 2 scenic walking trails on the shores of Lower Lough Erne and the remains of Castle Archdale.
