Tully Mill is an old flour mill run by Chef, John Roche. It can seat up to 60 guests and hosts Friday tapas night, Saturday evening a la carte, Sunday lunch, and events like weddings and parties.



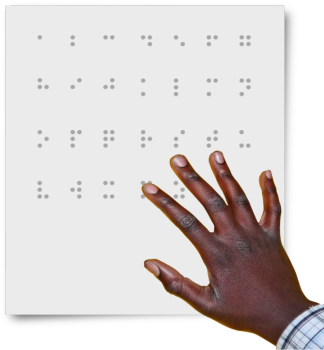
Parking is available for 25 cars near the entrance of the restaurant, with extra space nearby at the cottages. You will need your own car or a taxi to get to us.



The restaurant is on ground level and is wheelchair accessible. There is wide doorways and an accessible toilet.



If you would like to dine downstairs, you can access this via stairs or an outdoor ramp leads down to the bar entrance via the mill wheel.



We use local ingredients and offer gluten-free, vegan, and vegetarian choices. A braille menu is available.



Service dogs and emotional support animals are welcome.



We have a designated quiet balcony area for guests that may need time away from the noisy restaurant environment.



Inside, there may be strong smells from cooking and flowers. The lighting is low.



There is background music throughout the restaurant.

We grow herbs and use fresh seasonal produce from the Kitchen Garden at Florence Court Estate which cuts down on our food miles and supports local producers.
