The Boatyard Distillery



Know Before You Go Guide



The Boatyard Distillery is located a 15 minute drive from Enniskillen, Co Fermanagh. You can visit the distillery for a pre-booked 90 minute tasting tour, shop, eco-refill station, and events. This guide will help you get ready for your visit.

You can get to the distillery by car or boat, making it a unique place to visit.



A taxi from Enniskillen costs about £20 each way, and it's good for those who want the full tasting experience.



There are green electric gates at the entrance which will open on your approach. The site is shared with Tullybay Holiday Homes. The distillery is on your right hand side.



Parking is available, with a blue badge space near the entrance.



The distillery is in a converted boathouse. The entrance door is wide and pulls open. This area is the tour space and is step free and wheelchair accessible.



The floor is tiled and there is an open fire which is often lit on cold days or over Winter. There is floor to ceiling windows overlooking Tullybay Marina. There is some outdoor seating on the terrace.



The doors into the still room are double doors, and are push doors. This area is wheelchair accessible.



The bathrooms are accessible from the exterior of this building.



The tour continues into another building just below the Visitor Centre. To access this, you can either use the steps down to the Boat shed or take a short walk down a path. This path is accessible though there is a slight incline.



You will smell the distinctive aromas drifting through the distillery from the ingredients that go into the drinks.



The tour includes alcohol tastings. Non-drinking visitors are very welcome. Please mention this when booking so the team can prepare mocktail options in advance.



Please wear comfortable footwear suitable for a working distillery environment.



The experience is relaxed with small groups.



You can take home a bottle of Boatyard Gin.
