Welcome

Our staff are trained to help guests with varying accessibility needs and strive to provide a welcoming and supportive experience for all guests.



Accessible car parking spaces are beside the entrance of the hotel. A Concierge will welcome you on arrival and can assist with luggage.



The entrance has a wide, automatic door. There is step free access from the entrance to Reception.



All public areas within the hotel are accessible with wide corridors and double doors, including the restaurants. There is also accessible toilets in public areas in the hotel.



The Ross Suite is for events like weddings. It is fully accessible with a lift.



Lifts go to all bedroom floors. We have six accessible bedrooms. These have hearing loops and accessible bathrooms with emergency pull cords.



The resort has accessible with additional paved paths connecting the hotel to the lodges, golf clubhouse and access around our two championship golf courses.



Restaurant menus are available in clear, easy to read print.



Our library and lounge spaces provide quiet and comfortable areas where guests can relax.



Guide dogs and assistance animals are welcomed throughout the resort.



Sensory Tools in Nature

Stop and listen to the sounds around you. Hear the birds singing, and the wind moving through the trees.



Look at the trees and clouds in the sky. Can you spot shapes? It is calming to notice what's around you.

Watch how the plants and trees move in the wind. Sway like the trees. Moving your body can feel fun and help you feel good.



Listen to the lapping of the lough. This can help you relax.



Take a deep breath and notice the different scents. Smell the flowers, grass, and trees. Smelling nature can be relaxing and make you feel happy.
