Rushin House Caravan Park is a 5-star family run park near Belcoo village in Co Fermanagh. It is located on the shores of Lough MacNea. This guide will help you get ready for your visit.

Car parking is available on site next to your Caravan with space for larger vehicles and motorhomes. We do not accept tents at Rushin House Caravan Park.



There is free Wi-Fi throughout the park. You can enjoy hot showers, hairdryers, and a laundry room. There's a shared kitchen, and BBQ. The park has a boat slipway, play area, and football pitch.



The park has flat paths and is wheelchair accessible, including an access path to the lake. Toilet facilities on site are accessible. Lights across the park are on sensors or timers.



Rushin House Caravan Park is pet-friendly, so dogs are welcome.



The park can be busier in summer, but midweek and shoulder season visits offer a more peaceful experience.



Belcoo and Blacklion villages are near by with shops, pubs, restaurants and cafes available. Taxis are also available nearby.



Sensory Tools in Nature



Rushin House Caravan Park is very peaceful, with beautiful views of the surrounding landscape. The perfect place to relax or explore.



Stop and listen to the sounds around you. Hear the birds singing, and the wind moving through the trees.



Look at the trees and clouds in the sky. Can you spot shapes? It is calming to notice what's around you.



Put your feet in the grass. Feel the leaves. You can use these textures to stim or feel calm.



Watch how the plants and trees move in the wind. Sway like the trees. Moving your body can feel fun and help you feel good.



Take a deep breath and notice the different scents. Smell the flowers, grass, and trees. Smelling nature can be relaxing and make you feel happy.



Listen to the lapping of the lough. This can help you relax.
